March 19, 1925:

Jack had a rough time today going thru Huggins Hell, we sure both worked up a mighty appetite. Each meal starts with a mug of vegetable stew and a bucket of bread.

Beef Liver and Onions: \$15.99

Pan-seared fresh beef liver and sautéed Vidalia onions. Served with mashed potatoes, beef gravy and a side dish.

Ham Steak: \$17.99

"Town Folk" thick-cut brown sugar glazed ham, cornbread dressing, mashed potatoes with creamy chicken gravy, green beans and cranberry sauce.

Corned Beef and Cabbage: \$17.99

Braised brisket, mashed potatoes, stewed carrots and stewed cabbage. Served with a side of creamy horseradish.

Open-Faced Roast Beef: \$17.99

Thinly sliced all-natural beef chuck. Served over grilled bread, mashed potatoes with beef gravy and a side of green beans.

Fried Chicken: \$17.99

Deep fried double-breaded chicken breast. Served with mashed potatoes, creamy chicken gravy and a side dish.

Mountain Trout: \$18.99

Locally raised whole boneless rainbow trout broiled in lemon and butter. Served with tartar sauce and a side dish.

Fried Catfish: \$18.99

2 fresh cornmeal dusted filets, fried hush puppies, tartar sauce and a side dish.

June 6, 1925:

Me and Jack met a man at Icewater Spring, went by the name of Muir, real nice feller. We shared some of Momma's good smoked chicken.

Smoked Chicken: \$22.99

½ smoked chicken stuffed with cornbread dressing. Served with mashed potatoes, creamy chicken gravy and green beans.

Every Day is a Holiday in the Mountains: \$19.99

Smoked turkey, cornbread dressing, mashed potatoes with creamy chicken gravy, green beans and cranberry sauce.

Smoked Pork Chop: \$22.99

16 oz. all-natural smoked porterhouse pork chop mopped with our house BBQ sauce. Served with mashed potatoes with cream gravy and green beans.

Pulled Pork: \$16.99

Whole smoked pork butt basted in vinegar-based BBQ sauce and piled on grilled bread. Served with coleslaw and potato salad.

Smoked Meatloaf: \$16.99

Ground Chuck, tomatoes, fresh herbs, onion and celery. Smoked for hours and served with mashed potatoes, beef gravy and green beans.

Smoked Pork Ribs: \$32.99 / \$21.99

Full or half rack of house smoked pork ribs basted in a vinegar-based BBQ sauce. Served with potato salad and coleslaw.

Vegetable Plate (Choose 3 side dishes): \$12.99

Salad Dressings: Ranch, Honey Mustard, French, Bleu Cheese

Side Trail Garden Salad: \$11.99

Mixed greens, grape tomatoes, cucumbers, spring onion, pickled beets, fried okra croutons. Choice of dressing. Add fried chicken +\$3.99

Five Trails Salad: \$12.99

Mixed greens, baby peas, red onions, smoked bacon, diced celery, shredded cheddar, minced egg, grated parmesan, fried okra croutons and house dressing. Add fried chicken +\$3.99

Smoked Chicken Salad: \$15.99

Pulled smoked chicken, red onion, diced celery, fresh parsley, smoked bacon, fried okra croutons and grape tomatoes. Tossed with fresh greens and served with your choice of dressing.

September 13, 1925:

Cooler days are coming for me and Jack, the perfect time for Momma's cast-iron cake or caramel apple bread pudding. \$7.99

For the Youngins: \$7.99

Corn Dog

Deep fried all beef corndog with a bag of chips.

Grilled cheese

Double American cheese grilled on fresh-baked bread and a bag of chips.

Fried Chicken Tenders

Served with one side dish.

Meatloaf

Served with one side dish.

Pulled Pork

Served with one side dish.

Vegetable Plate

Choose three side dishes.

August 22, 1925:

Even up top its hotter than the dickens, better make sure you get enough to drink before you pass last water.
